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**EXPANSION:** Millet (0017) insurance plans were established in Cheyenne (023), Sherman (181) and Wallace (199) Counties.

The Revenue Assurance Plan (25) is available for Sunflowers (0078).

**DELETIONS:** N/A

**DATES:** The Final Planting Date for Cotton has been changed in all counties to 06/01.

The Final Planting Date for Soybeans has been changed in Cherokee (021), Crawford (037), Labette (099), Montgomery (125), Neosho (133) and Wilson (205) Counties.

**STATEMENTS:** Crop rotation restrictions relating to Sunflower insurability have changed. Sunflowers, planted on acreage that had soybeans planted in the previous crop year, are now insurable.

Organic practice statements added to the SPOI. Transitional and certified organic production including that from buffer strips must be kept in separate Actual Production History databases.

**PRACTICES/TYPES:** The non-irrigated farming practice is now insurable for cotton programs established in Grant (067), Gray (069), Haskell (081), Meade (119), Morton (129), Seward (175), Stanton (187) and Stevens (189) Counties.

**TRANSITIONAL YIELDS:** N/A

**OTHER:** An Organic Rate Factor of 1.05 has been added for all crops – see the FCI-35.

A rate review was completed for Corn (0041), Grain Sorghum (0051), Popcorn (0043) and Soybeans (0081). Some county rates have changed – see the FCI-35.
