

2004 NEBRASKA ACTUARIAL DOCUMENTS CHANGES

11/30-12/31 FILING

EXPANSION: The Revenue Assurance plan of coverage has been added to Corn and Soybeans in all counties.

DELETIONS: N/A

DATES: A statement was added to the Millet Special Provisions of Insurance in all counties which extends the insurance period for Millet, that has been swathed and windrowed by 9/30, from 10/15 to 10/31.

The Millet final planting date has been changed from 06/20 to 06/25 in all counties.

STATEMENTS: Crop rotation restrictions relating to Sunflower insurability have changed. Sunflowers, planted on acreage that had soybeans planted in the previous crop year, are now insurable.

A statement was added to all Sugar Beet counties that allows for insurance to attach on acreage after the discovery of rhizomania if the acreage is planted to a rhizomania resistant variety approved by the contracting sugar beet company.

Corrected the Potato full maturity statement to reference the appropriate section of the crop provisions. Corrected Section 12 to Section 11.

Organic practice statements added to the SPOI. Transitional and certified organic production including that from buffer strips must be kept in separate Actual Production History databases.

PRACTICES/TYPES: The non-irrigated practice for GRP Corn was removed in Frontier (063), Furnas (065), Kearney (099), Perkins (135), Polk (143), Valley (175) & York (185) Counties.

The irrigated practice for GRP Corn was added to Gage (067) County.

The 997 practice was removed for GRP Soybeans in Seward (159) County and was replaced by separate irrigated and non-irrigated practices.

TRANSITIONAL YIELDS: N/A

OTHER: An Organic Rate Factor of 1.05 has been added for all crops – see the FCI-35.

A rate review was completed for Corn (0041), Grain Sorghum (0051), Popcorn (0043), Soybeans (0081) and Sugar Beets (0039). Some county rates have changed – see the FCI-35.

County high- risk rates have been updated for Brown (017), Garfield (071), Holt (089), Rock (149) & Wheeler (183) Counties – see the FCI-35.
